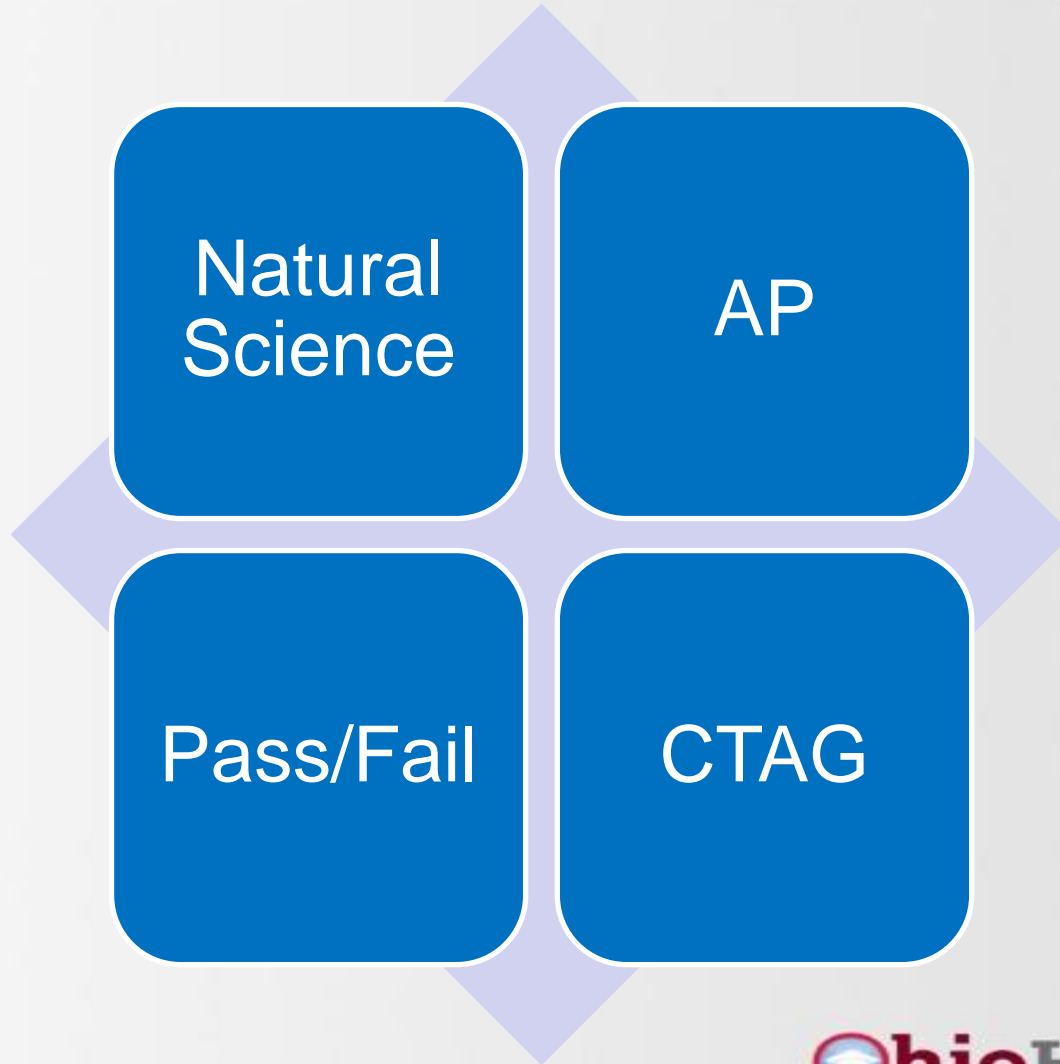

## AP exams scores



Ohio Articulation and Transfer policy for the spring 2020 term reads that the AP Exam scores will be accepted for college credit, using the same guarantees that exist in current policy.



## Pass/Fail Grades

Students who receive Pass (or credit) for a course taken during the Spring 2020 and Summer 2020 terms will be guaranteed to receive transfer credit and have that credit applied as if it were a letter grade according to current OATN policy.

| F (on P/F scale)     | N - Not Proficient    |





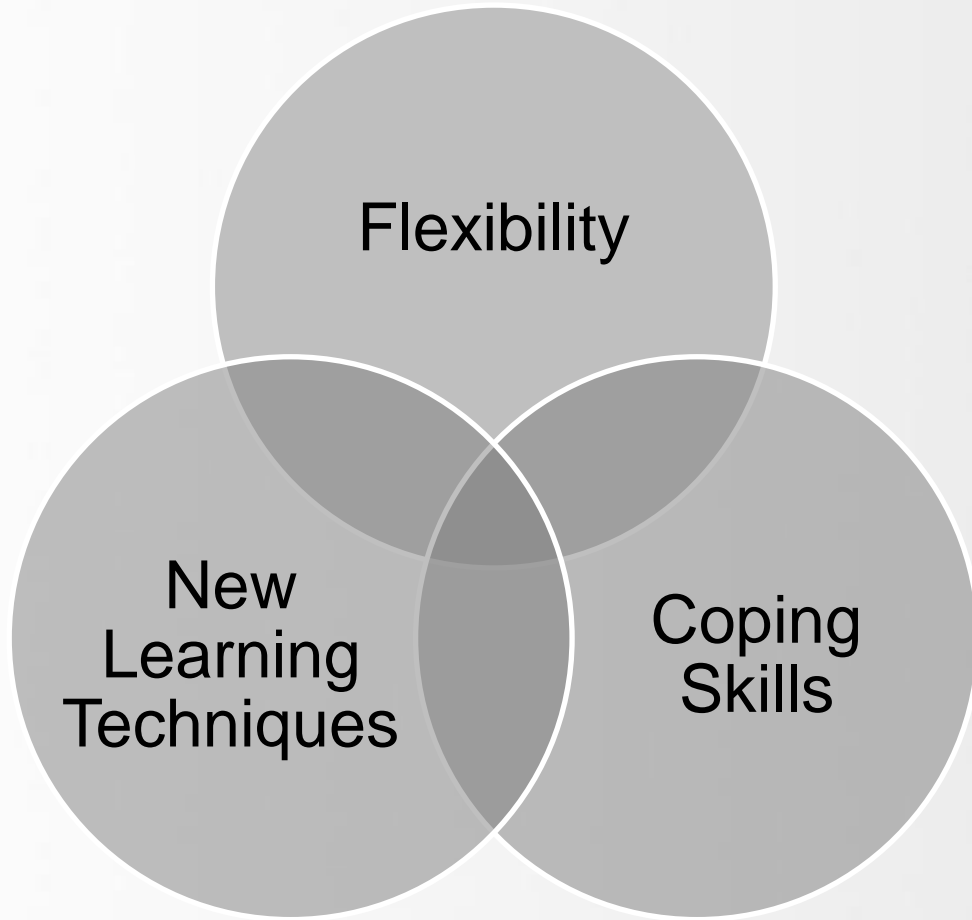

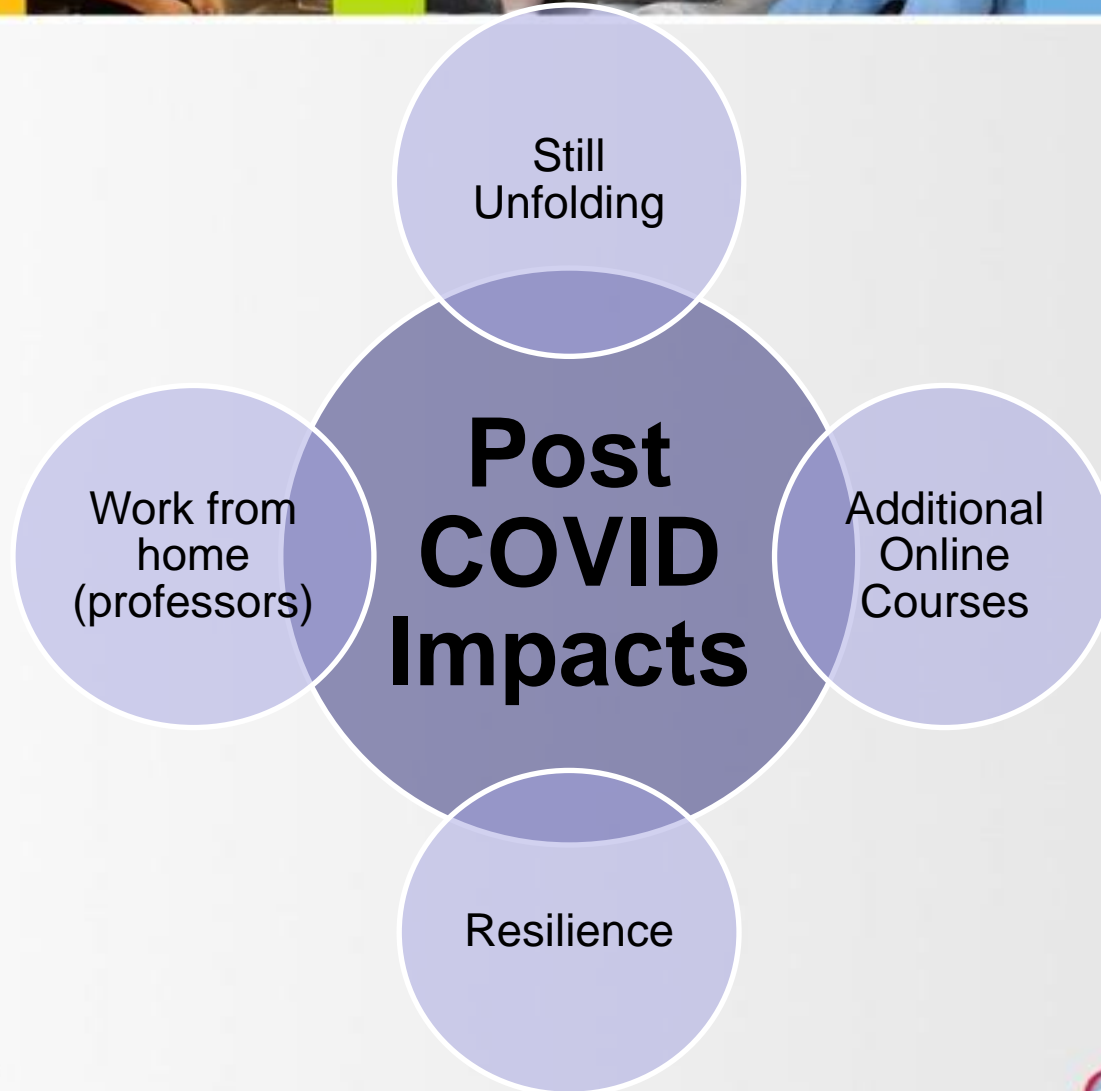
