OUR STORY ARMSTRONG STATE & GEORGIA SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY

- Consolidated in 2018
- Two different student populations were served on each campus
- This event was originally developed by Armstrong to tailor to Transfer, Adult, and Non-Traditional Students
- Campus partners were approached and brought onboard to assist with the event

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO START NOW? FROM APPLICATION TO ENROLLED IN ONE DAY

- Can apply for free before or during the event
- Meet with an admissions counselor to discuss options
- Speak with a financial aid counselor to explore financial options
- Meet with an academic advisor to get registered for classes
- Take the Accuplacer Exam
- Register for SOAR- Southern's Orientation, Advisement and Registration

START NOW EVENT PROCESS FOR NEW STUDENTS

- Register to attend an event by campus
- Complete the admissions application for free
- Apply at least one day prior to the Start Now event
- Gather official copies of transcripts from all schools attended
- Arrive anytime between 10:00 am and 6:00 pm on the day of the event
- Students must attend the event on the campus in which they would like to enroll

START NOW EVENT PROCESS FOR FORMER STUDENTS

- Complete the Former Student Application
- Order official transcripts from all schools attended and have them sent to Georgia Southern University – Office of the Registrar
- Students must attend the event on the campus in which they would like to enroll

- Cannot receive financial aid in time to start term
- Attendance at orientation
